

A child will be admitted to junior kindergarten (JK), senior kindergarten (SK), or 1st grade if he/she is four years old, five years old, or six years old, respectively, by September 1 in the year he/she is to enter the designated grade. Early admission/early entrance means enrolling a child in school prior to the designated legal age requirements specified above. Early admission/early entrance shall only be granted if it is in the best interest of the child following a comprehensive evaluation. A child can be denied early admission due to availability of seats at the respected grade level.
