Richmond School District will provide an education for employment program for Kindergarten through eighth grade students which has been developed in accordance with state guidelines and has been approved by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Through the implementation of Academic and Career Planning (ACP) all students shall have access to an education for employment program which provides for the following:

- 1. Career awareness in grades Kindergarten through fifth grade.
- 2. Career exploration in grades 6 through 8. Career exploration shall address stereotyping and may include work-based learning experiences and career research identifying personal preferences in relation to future work roles.

The District Administrator/designee shall coordinate the education for employment program in accordance with state laws and regulations. Education for employment program records and reports shall be made as required by the Department of Public Instruction.
