Richmond School Safety Plan

The Richmond School Safety Plan provides action plans and checklists for scenarios that can potentially impact the health and safety of students and staff. The safety plan is reviewed and approved by the board of education for compliance with Act 143.

In addition to the safety plan, there are several safety and security systems in place at Richmond, which include:

- twenty-seven security cameras throughout the interior and exterior building, which were funded by the Department of Justice Safety Grant
- new outdoor key fob access system
- one-touch 911 notification system
- video camera entry system
- new PA system

The District provides staff with safety training each year and conducts numerous drills, per WI Statute, including drills for fire, lockdowns, and evacuation situations. Emergency evacuation information is also posted in each classroom. Your child's safety is our number one concern. We are committed to providing a safe and secure learning environment for all of our students and staff.
