



Lunch Account Procedures

Richmond School utilizes the Tyler Inc. SisK12 software program. When using it, parents are requested to deposit sufficient funds to cover the next month's lunch expenses. Cash or checks may be sent to the school office, or payments may be made online through the E-funds website.

Parents should monitor the balance in the account through the Parent Portal and are encouraged to deposit funds on a regular basis. If your child(ren)'s lunch account balance reaches zero or below, our system generates an email notifying you to make a payment immediately.

- 1. If your child's lunch account becomes negative, he/she will be able to charge only one (1) lunch from the daily lunch menu selections.
- 2. If the account remains negative for a second and third day, a sandwich alternative and milk will be served to the student.
- 3. On the fourth day, if the account is still negative, parents will need to send a lunch to school with their child(ren).

Families qualifying for free or reduced lunch receive services based on federal guidelines and state regulations.

Cash or Check Payments:

Payments are deposited in an individual student account. If you have more than one child at Richmond you must make separate deposits into each account. One family check can be written out as long as you indicate on the memo line how much you would like allocated to each child's account. Please make checks payable to "Richmond School".

Electronic Payments:

You can make an electronic deposit through E-funds via our Richmond School website. The link can be found under the "For Parents" tab, then "Lunch Information" and finally "Online Account Payments."

If you are new to E-funds, you will be asked for your student's ID number. It is your child's lunch pin number. Please be sure to link all of your children to your account and allocate money for each child.

Tyler SIS Student 360 Navigation for Parent Portal

To begin using the Parent Portal, follow these steps:

- 1. A link to setup your password will be emailed to the address you provided on the registration form.
- 2. Go to Richmond School website and under For Parents/SISK12 Parent Portal tab.
- 3. Click on the Parent tab and then log in. You must be on the Parents tab in order for your login to work.

School Messenger

School Messenger is the system we use for phone calls and emails throughout the year.

There are only **two requirements** for a recipient to receive the messages:

- 1. the recipient's cell phone number and
- 2. opt-in confirmation from you.

Your cell number must be in the School Messenger database. This number is updated every evening through our Tyler SIS. The number used is the number you provided us in the parent portal. If your number changes you must update the parent portal.

Recipients can easily opt-in by to text messages by simply sending the word **Yes**, via text message, to the number **68453**.

To opt out of all text messages from SchoolMessenger, visit http://www.schoolmessenger.com/txtmsg/ or reply with STOP to the opt-message that you receive. If you opt in, but decided to opt out later, you may also reply "STOP" to any message or send "STOP" to 68453.

The school district does not pay for text message charges that may be incurred by you for sending or receiving text messages. Check with your wireless carrier for possible charges.
